



Corinella Boat Ramp Facility Usage Terms & Conditions

- You must always observe and comply with any direction displayed on a sign or notice erected on or near the boat launching facilities and all directions issued by the Corinella Foreshore Reserve Committee of Management Inc.
- The Committee disclaims any liability for injury, loss or damage incurred while accessing and using the boat launching facilities, jetties, fish cleaning facilities, car parks or surrounding facilities. Access and use of these facilities is at your own risk. By using these facilities, you have agreed that you are aware of the following potential hazards: .
 - a. Due to tidal action, the depth of the water adjacent to or near the boat launching facility may be insufficient to enable a boat to be launched or used safely.
 - b. Due to wave action and propeller wash, rocks and other hidden obstructions may occasionally be present on or near the lower edge of the ramps. To avoid potential damage to boat hulls and propellers, it is your responsibility to ensure that there are no obstructions present before launching or retrieving boats.
 - c. People who are not confident with using ladders should avoid using the jetty ladders on either jetty, and should use the floating pontoon for access.

Hours of Operation

- The ramp and facilities are available for use at all times.
- In some cases, maintenance work may require temporary closure of part of the facility. Closures will be advised via the website and email to ramp news subscribers.

Parking

- Parking for vehicles with trailers is designated on the reserve bordered by Smythe, Peters and The Esplanade. Vehicle-only parking is available on the western side of the Jetty Shed.
- Parking availability is not guaranteed.
- Please do not leave valuables in parked vehicles.
- 10 min standing in the designated de-rigging lanes only

Fish Cleaning

- Fish cleaning facilities should be left clean after use.
- Please ensure that fish carcasses are thrown below the high-water mark
- Please park in the parking area whilst cleaning fish.
